
ENGLAND SQUASH COACH LICENCE - ENSURING THE FUTURE QUALITY OF COACHING

Clubs should also be aware that their coaches must have attended 3 courses – Equity in Your Coaching, Good Practice and Child Protection and First Aid – as well as having completed an England Squash CRB Check and be a current appropriately insured coaching member of England Squash.
