

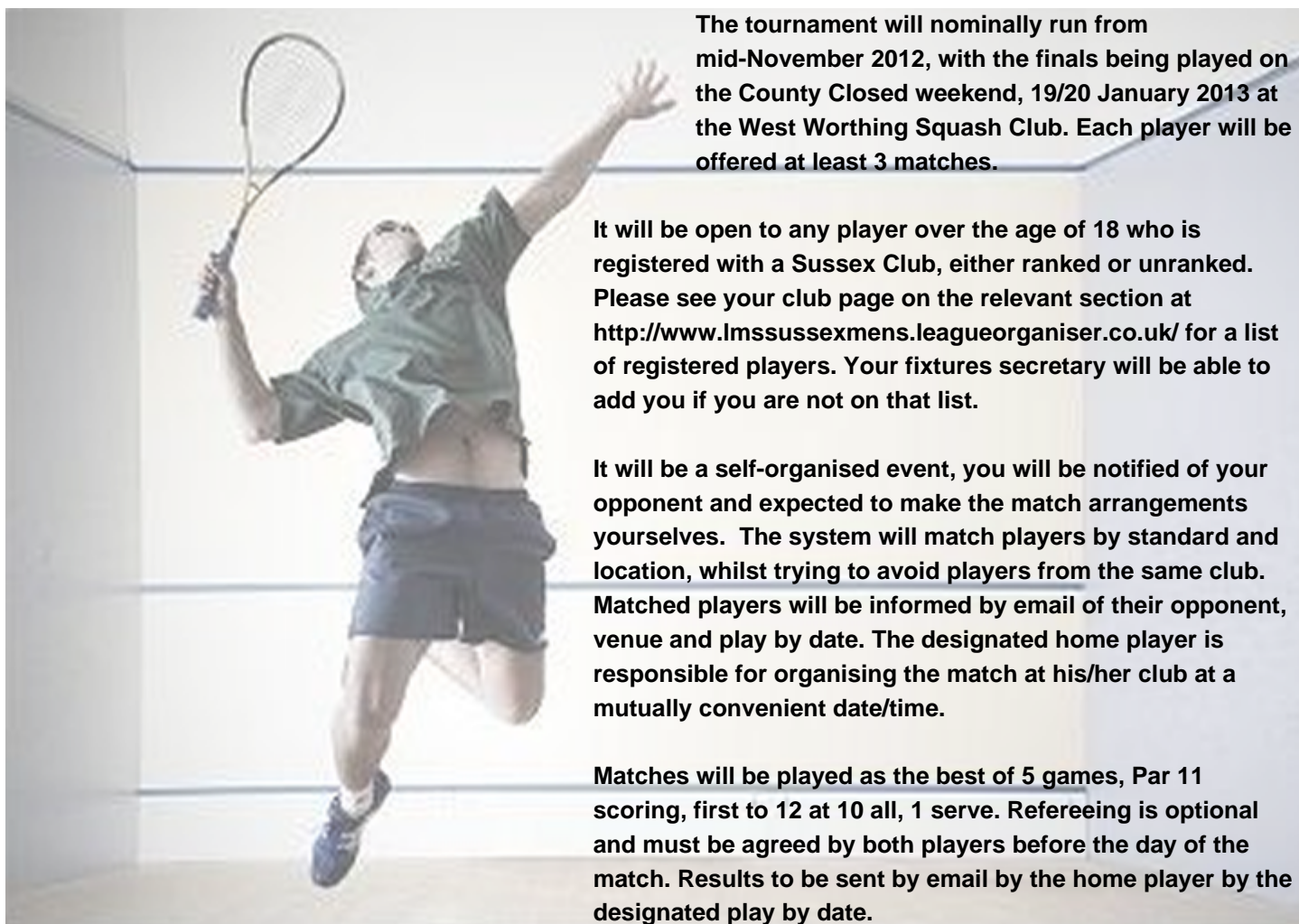

Sussex County Closed Squash Competition 2012



The tournament will nominally run from mid-November 2012, with the finals being played on the County Closed weekend, 19/20 January 2013 at the West Worthing Squash Club. Each player will be offered at least 3 matches.

It will be open to any player over the age of 18 who is registered with a Sussex Club, either ranked or unranked. Please see your club page on the relevant section at <http://www.lmssussexmens.leagueorganiser.co.uk/> for a list of registered players. Your fixtures secretary will be able to add you if you are not on that list.

It will be a self-organised event, you will be notified of your opponent and expected to make the match arrangements yourselves. The system will match players by standard and location, whilst trying to avoid players from the same club. Matched players will be informed by email of their opponent, venue and play by date. The designated home player is responsible for organising the match at his/her club at a mutually convenient date/time.

Matches will be played as the best of 5 games, Par 11 scoring, first to 12 at 10 all, 1 serve. Refereeing is optional and must be agreed by both players before the day of the match. Results to be sent by email by the home player by the designated play by date.

The entrance fee is £5.00 per player to be paid online by credit card via Google Checkout. No refunds will be available after your entry has been confirmed.



£1.00 of the fee will be returned to your club funds to directly benefit your players in the form of reduced league fees (i). Try and involve all your players, especially those who play only in your internal leagues, to help raise club funds.
