

NATIONAL CHAMPION

Great Result for Torrie Malik (Sussex) this weekend (Sat 1st/Sun 2nd June) as she has become England Squash and Racketball National u11s Girls Squash Champion 2013. (Held at the National Squash Centre Manchester)

Torrie was seeded 2 for the annual event, and won all her matches 3-0 taking the National Title a year early as she is only 9 years old, so also has next year to defend her new National Crown. What makes this even more of an achievement is that Torrie thought Squash was a Boys game and would not come training with her Brothers until about just over 2 years ago, when she noticed her triplet younger brothers could hit the ball more often than she could, so the penny dropped and I think she just felt she needed to have a go before they got left behind!!!

The triplet brothers came, Heston 40th, Bailey 47th and Sumner 51st in the Boys National Squash u11s event this being their first one aged only 7, so they also have 3 more goes at the age group. Perry one of her older brothers came 3rd in the Boys event last year.
