**Please note that ALL players who are involved with Sussex activities, and especially those who are in line for a Team, are expected to make every effort to attend all the Sussex Squads, unless there is a pressing reason to miss a session – regular attendance assures better continuity, more sustained improvement, and better team spirit. The Schedule has been drawn-up to allow players to attend County, Regional, Super-Regional, and National Squad Training, with a minimum of clashes, and to avoid any Silver Events, so that all our players are able to attend. This, in turn, necessitates scheduling some Sussex Squads on weekends when there are Bronze Events taking place, but care has been taken to avoid coinciding with the more local tournaments, wherever possible. The aim is to encourage all Juniors to fully utilise the coaching opportunities offered to them, in order to keep developing their game, whilst selectively entering tournaments, for the enjoyment and experience of competition which they provide, together with gaining some ranking points!**

**Please note that the November Squad, important for selection and preparation for the Inter-County Stage 2, has to be on the w/e of 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>, which clashes with the One-Day Events at Surrey (Saturday) and Chichester (Sunday) – to support the local event, the Sussex Squads have been reversed, with the ‘A’ and ‘B’ Sessions on the Saturday, and the ‘Feeder’ Session (involving fewer tournament players) on the Sunday, so you can all enter the Chichester Open!**
