6. Junior County Squads	
Feedback from LW was we got five teams out for the inter county, unfortunately could not get the girls U19 out. Five teams through to the finals at Nottingham. LW about to send out email with all the info for the teams. He will nominate a team manager and captain to support the weekend. All in all boys quite stron and the girls slightly weaker as have no U11 or U17 girls teams. Lots ot postive LW established a good relationship with Kit and Ben and they are happier now	ng

LW is there to support. Turn out not huge and players being selected even if not attending county squads and money collection not the best again. However some players have fully paid for the season especially in the feeder squad which is a positive. With having only one coach at each sessions does make it more cost effective. CRM mentioned they got 17 for the November sessions however only 5 have actually paid although LW mentioned a lot were from the feeder squad. ST agreed to send LW notes that Graham Stevenson drafted around his role. PM mentioned about paying LW for his work or least expenses and it was agreed this would be good however we do need to ensure we can collect fees as we need to cover costs. CRM has managed to secure £1000 again from the trading post and he will draft an email to request the funds and send asap with our bank details. CM confimed he would send CRM an invoice for the money. LW asked do the clubs support for the county teams and CM confirmed there is a subsidy to the junior account from the senior account to support the squads. LW feels the engagement between clubs and the county squads is limited and feels there needs to be a way to get both groups working together.
